Mr. Richard Head the summ of Sixty seven Pounds, being money heretofore given and sometime since deposited in his hands to and for the use of the Poor of the Parish of Sherrington in the County of Wilts And I do hereby Promise to pay to the Minister Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish of Sherrington for the time being the said Summ of Sixty seven Pounds on Demand together with Interest for the sume after the rate of four pounds for un Hundred by the year to be computed from the twenty fifth day of December last past the said Mr. Head having paid the Interest of the same summ from the said twenty fifth day of December until the Date hereof us Witness my hand the day and year first above written
