

Swindon & District Directory Extract 1928 South Marston



SOUTH MARSTON was formerly included in the parish of Highworth, but, by an order of the Wilts County Council, was formed into a separate parish in 1894. It is 2 miles from Stratton Station (G.W.R) and 4 miles from Swindon and is in the Swindon Division of Wilts, Swindon and Highworth Union. Petty Sessional Division and County Court District of Swindon and Diocese of Bristol. The register of the church dates from 1529, and the living, value £244, with residence, is in the patronage of the Bishop of Bristol. The schools, which were generously built for the benefit of the parishioners by the late Lord of the Manor, Mr. Alfred Bell, are worthy of special mention on account of their singular beauty and completeness in every respect. There is a Wesleyan Chapel. Mr. J. Ashfordby Trenchard and Lord Banbury of Southam are the principal landowners. There is a prosperous Lodge of Odd Fellows in the village. Area, 1,911 acres; rateable value, £7,166; population, 363. Letters arrive through Swindon, and are despatched at 6.45 p.m. Stratton is the nearest telegraph and Money Order Office.
