Item I give all my lynnen unto my two daughters Edith and Dorathie equally to be devided betwene them at the discretion of my sonne Charles Blake Item I give unto my daughter Anconett Burges three shillings and fower pence Item I give unto my daughter Agnis Henstitch three shillings and fower pence Item I give unto my daughter Margarett Hayter three shillings and fower pence Item I give unto William Hayter my daughter's childe a sheepe worthe five shillings Item I give unto my sonne John his childe a sheepe worthe five shillinges.
