## **DEVIZES UNION**

All Persons desirous of CONTRACTING with the Board of Guardians of this Union for supplying the Workhouse at Devizes with all or any of the undermentioned Articles from the 24th day of June, until and inclusive of the 29th day of September following, are requested to deliver at the Board Room, in the Devizes Workhouse, (free of expense), sealed Tenders, marked "Provision Tender" or "Clothing Tender" on or before ten o'clock in the forenoon of TUESDAY the 19th day of June instant.

Samples will be expected to be produced for the inspection of the Board.

The Articles to be delivered at the Workhouse in such quantities and at such times as the Board of Guardians may direct.

Security must be given (if required) for the due performance of the Contracts.

All Bills due from the Union to be sent to the Finance Committee at the Workhouse, on or before THURSDAY the 21st of June instant.
