Steeple Ashton

1845

Inquest Held by George Sylvester Esq. - At Steeple Ashton on Thomas Guy who was driving a timber carriage towards Westbury Leigh, riding on the timbers. On attempting to get down, his clothes caught and he was pulled under the wheels, which passed over him, inflicting a comminated fracture of both bones of the right leg and other extensive lacerations of the integuments from the effects of which, he died in a month.

Verdict:- 'Accidental death'.
