

CORONERS INQUESTS



Steeple Ashton

1842

Inquest - Nov 12, at Hinton in the parish of Steeple Ashton, on James Kingham, aged 38 years, carter to Mr Porter of Seend Row. Deceased was proceeding from Poulshot, riding on his waggon laden with wheat, and while placing some false raves, he was jerked off into the road, which produced an extensive wound of the scalp and subsequently lock jaw. Verdict – Accidental Death.
