

Extracts from Stockton Parish Register

Interesting Parish Register Entries

1628

20 November - Here end the entries made by Thomas Crockford; the next six entries were probably made by Dr. Greene, Rector or his Curate Will Greene.

1643

Page 12 of this Register (Stockton Marriage Register) is damaged or defaced in some way, probably accidentally, but all entries have been carefully copied on to page 14 at same time. Page 13 is blank. The next 22 entries are well and carefully written.

1695

20 July - Dionisius Lariler Miles & Elizabeth Woodford

[Query, Is the surname Lariler or Miles? Does Miles mean that the man was a soldier? There is no stop after Lariler. Two Christian names are very unusual for this period].

1790

James White, Parish Clerk died.

1803

A Soldier in ye Guards lost an eye in Egypt receives an out pension from Chelsea – Died in decline he was wounded in his arm in Battle.

1804

[start missing] I with my Inquest the day and year hereunder written have taken the view the Body of Elizabeth Shirt who now lies dead in your Parish, and have proceeded therein according to Law.

These are Therefore to Certify that you may lawfully permit the Body of the said Elizabeth Shirt to be buried; and for your so doing this is your warrant.

Given under my hand & Seal this 14th day of May 1804.
