



Brewery Farm

Was built 1773 in Swindon Road, the 1796 Enclosure Award was made to a James White.

By 1841 Richard White had taken over and had started brewing.

The home of the former Star Brewery it was bought by Arkell's in 1896 and in 1926 Arkell's sold it to Edward John Cook.

The farm was a working Dairy Farm until after World War II.

In 1980 the Farm House became a Grade II listed building.

The Farm House remained in the Cook Family until December 2006 when it was bought and converted to a bed & breakfast.

The Malt house is now used by the UNITE union as offices.
