STRATTON FACTORY SALE

There is yet to be another big sale at the Government munitions factory at Stratton, arising out of the demolition of a portion of the buildings. This will be held at the factory on Wednesday, 15 July, commencing at 11 a.m., and will be conducted by Messrs. Hall, Pain and Foster, of Fareham and Portsmouth.

The numerous lots to be auctioned will include 120,000 run f timber, 100 glazed steel windows, 265,000 bricks and paving tiles, 50,000 blue Staffordshire bricks, 50,000 yellow stock bricks, 100,000 paving bricks, 50,000 red bricks etc.

The lots will be on view three days before the sale. The remainder of the buildings, with the site, are still for sale
