

CORONERS INQUESTS



Inquest Report on John Cully

At Badbury, in the parish of Chiseldon, inquest on the body of John Cully, wagoner to Mr. Richard Brunsden, of Stratton St. Margaret, near Swindon.

Deceased was proceeding home from Marlborough, with his master's wagon loaded with sacks of beans, when on going down Badbury hill, close by the Plough Inn, the horse became unmanageable, and went off at a rapid pace.

Deceased, whilst endeavouring to get down from the head of the wagon, fell under the wheels, and was killed on the spot.

Verdict - Accidental death.
