Inquest Report on Unnamed Boy

Another inquest was held at Stratton St. Margaret on the body of a poor boy, who had been employed the preceding Saturday in leading a horse about the sides of the road to feed. It appeared that he had incautiously fastened the rope round his wrist, that the horse ran away, and dragged him a considerable distance, whereby he was instantly deprived on life
