

John Herring Trust

Set up in 1725 to educate 6 Stratton schoolchildren. John Herring was a local Baptist. Distributed and yielding £3 per annum of which £2:10s is applied in providing yearly prizes for scholars belonging to the elementary schools in the parish and the remaining 10s is given to four widows, reported in 1901 Parish minute book and still running in 1967.

John Herring Crescent is named after him.
