

The Parish History

Following a Community Governance Review by Swindon Borough Council it was decided to annex Nythe Estate from Stratton St. Margaret Parish Council and set up its own Parish Council with 7 member councillors. This became effective from 1st April 2015 with an interim council and following the local elections on May 7th the first full council was held at the Community Room, The Drive, Nythe on Tuesday 19th May. The 3 elected councillors Dale Heenan, Richard Hurley and Kevin Perry attended with Sean Banks acting as Locum Clerk. 11 members of the public attended. Dale Heenan was elected as Chairman and asked for locals to put their names forward to be co-opted to the council to make up to the full compliment of 7.
