



Obituary of Mr. W. Osland Hill, 1905

DEATH OF MR. W. HILL, FORMER SCHOOLMASTER AT STRATTON.

We regret to announce that the death of Mr W Osland Hill, of Westlecott Road, Swindon, took place at The National Hospital, London, at ten o'clock on Wednesday morning. The deceased had been suffering for some time from an internal complaint and had been in the London Hospital for nine weeks.

Mr Hill retired from a schoolmastership at Stratton, under the Stratton School Board about two years ago.

Mr Hill has been secretary to the Stratton St. Margaret Perfect Thrift Building Society and also to the Permanent Money Society for some time. He was also an estate agent and an accountant, and secretary to the Swindon Ratepayers Association, discharging his duties in relation to all there with great ability and success. The Perfect Thrift Society in particular, will greatly miss the services of an energetic worker.
