Rights of Way - Parish of Stratton St Margaret

I refer to your letter dated 22nd October 1986 addressed to the County Surveyor which has been passed to me to reply in respect of the Reviews.

I return herewith the copy documents which arrived with your letter and which I identify as follows:-

- Marked 'A' this is the provisional Definitive Map which became the Definitive Map in 1958.
- 'B' shows the changes proposed at the First Review on 1st September 1958 and is stapled to the schedule of changes involved.
- 'C' appears to be a copy of the Definitive Map as it would be at the completion of the Review with certain post review amendments.
- 'D' like 'B' shows the changes proposed at the Second and Special Review on 31st May 1972 and published on 30th November 1972.

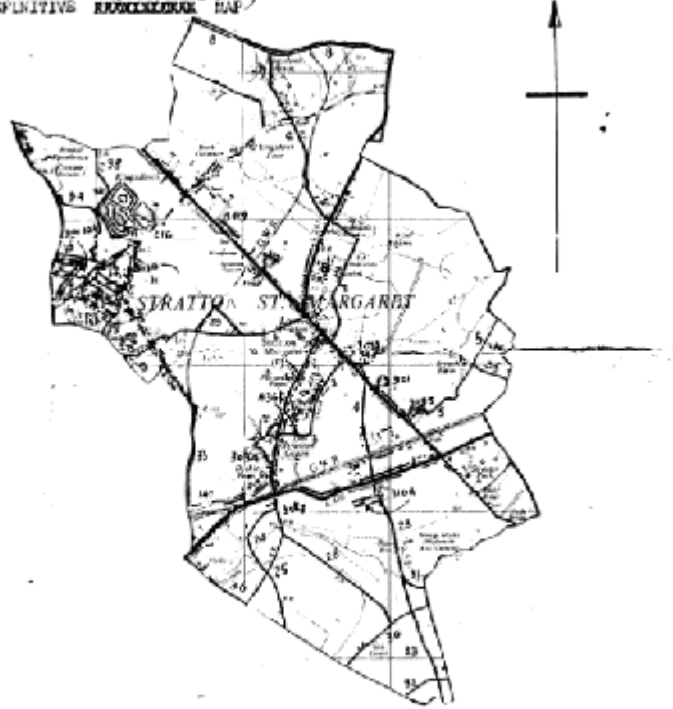
