Stratton St. Margaret

The parish of Stratton St. Margaret adjoins Swindon. It is in the Devizes Court District of Swindon. There are two railway stations, one on the Highworth branch line and the other on the main line, at the Park Cross Roads, Lower Stratton. The Parish Church of St. Margaret has a register dating from 1608 and there is a church dedicated to St. Phillip, at Upper Stratton. In addition, there are three Methodist Chapels and two Baptist Chapels. The population is about 6,350; the rateable value £29,323; and the product of a penny rate £120 19s. 6d.
