

Bakers Arms

121 Beechcroft Road (96 & 130 Kingsdown Road), Erected c1847 by a butcher, William Slade of The Red Lion, Moredon. Originally also a bakery. When in charge Perrin also sold them beer to drink with their Sunday dinners which landed him a hefty fine. The local constable discovered beer mugs hidden in the oven! It is not recorded when it stopped making bread. Pub consisted of tap room, bar, cellar, kitchen, 5 bedrooms, together with stabling, coach house, bake house with loft, wash house coal shed and yard when it was bought by Arkells in 1896 with rental value of £40, full licence 1947, renovated 1956, extended 1984 and again in 2014

In 1866 Mr Perrin was fined for selling beer to men cooking their Sunday lunch in his ovens. 1960's landlord Frank Clarke was lead alto saxophone in the Johny Stiles band

1867 Mullings & Co of Cirencester appeared on behalf of William Perrin for renewal of licence. Approved. *North Wilts Herald 02-09-1867*.

1879 Joseph Carter, labourer, of Swindon charged with being drunk & disorderly and refusing to leave the Bakers Arms on 16th August. Fined 10s and £1 1s costs. *North Wilts Herald 25-08-1879.*

1907 Landlord Albert GIBBS fined for obstruction. Swindon Advertiser 29-11-1907.

1910 Licenence transferred to William COUSINS. Swindon Advertiser 28-10-1910.

1960's landlord Frank Clarke was lead alto saxophone in the Johny Stiles band
