## Sutton Mandeville

At the County Court of Dorsetshire, holden at Shaftesbury, before William E. Burridge, Registrar:

Charles Hibberd, of Sutton Mandeville, in the county of Wilts, Stone Mason and Farmer, adjudicated bankrupt on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1867. A Dividend Meeting will be held on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September next, at twelve o'clock at noon precisely.

In the County Court of Wiltshire, holden at Salisbury.

In the Matter of a Special Resolution for Liquidation by Arrangement of the affairs of Henry Marsh, of Sutton Mandeville, in the county of Wilts, Farmer.
