Sutton Mandeville

At the County Court of Dorsetshire, holden at Shaftesbury, before William E. Burridge, Registrar:

Charles Hibberd, of Sutton Mandeville, in the county of Wilts, Stone Mason and Farmer, adjudicated bankrupt on the 25th day of May, 1867. A Dividend Meeting will be held on the 17th day of September next, at twelve o'clock at noon precisely.

The Bankruptcy Act, 1869

In the County Court of Wiltshire, holden at Salisbury.

In the Matter of a Special Resolution for Liquidation by Arrangement of the affairs of Henry Marsh, of Sutton Mandeville, in the county of Wilts, Farmer.

The creditors of the above-named Henry Marsh who have not already proved their debts, are required, on or before the 30th day of April, 1880, to send their names and addresses, and the particulars of their debts or claims, to me, the undersigned, Frederick Aston Dawes, of City-chambers, Salisbury, in the county of Wilts, Auctioneer, the Trustee under the liquidation, or in default thereof they will be excluded from the benefit of the Dividend proposed to be declared. – Dated this 15th day of April, 1880.
