<u>Two Bealing Monuments</u> <u>in Churchyard</u>

Located: About 6 metres south of Chancel of Church of All Saints, Sutton Mandeville, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 27th July, 1985

Two chest tombs. Early C18. Limestone. Each tomb has plinth, recessed panel to main sides and to ends, corner pilasters with recessed panels, south of two has cavetto-moulded flat top with inscription and reset late C17 panel on north face; to Henery (sic) Bealing died 1680. North of pair has flat top with illegible inscription, south panel has inscription to Margat (sic) Bealing, died 1713.
