NON-PAYMENT OF POOR RATES

Robert Bracher Larkham, of Sutton Mandeville, was summoned by the overseers of that parish for refusing to pay a poor rate, amounting to 5 ℓ . 8 s. Mr Hawkins, the overseer, said the rate was made on the 14th of November last, and allowed by the justices on the 15th November. Defendant was rated in the sum of 5 ℓ . 8 s., and the amount had not been paid. Defendant did not appear, and the Bench granted a warrant of distress for the amount of the rate and costs.
