Petitions against the abolition of church-rates were presented by Lord H. THYNNE, from the clergy and lay consultees of the deanery of Wylye, and from the following parishes – Brixton Deverill, Kingston Deverill, Hill Deverill, Maiden Bradley, Corsley, Sedghill, Swallowcliffe, Chicklade, Donhead St. Mary, Easy Knoyle, West Knoyle, Berwick St. John, Sutton Mandeville, all in the diocese of Salisbury; and by Mr BONHAM-CARTER, from the master and brethren of St. Cross Hospital, and parishioners of St. Cross.
