FUNERAL DELAYED BY THUNDERSTORM

The funeral of Mrs Mary L. Everett, of "Hazlecroft", Devizes, daughter of the late Mr Ed. Heath, J. P., of Liverpool, and widow of the Rev. Arthur J. Everett, M.A. (late Rector of Sutton Veny), and vicar of Berry Pomeroy (Devon), was delayed for nearly three-quarters of an hour at Sutton Veny, Warminster, on Saturday afternoon, owing to a deluge of rain, accompanied with heavy thunder and lightning. The interment was in the family vault in the churchyard. Among the mourners present were Mrs Chorley and the Rev. E. A. Chorley (Vicar of Netheravon, daughter and soon-in-law), the Rev. B. C. S. Everett (minor Canon of St. George's Chapel, Windsor, son), and Mr L. D. L. Everett (son, Assistant Chief Constable, Liverpool).
