

Harrod's Directory Extract 1865

Sutton Veny



Sutton Veney is a village and parish close to Tytherington, in the hundred and union of Warminster, South Wilts, distant 3 miles S.E. by S. from Warminster station, and 2 S.W. from Heytesbury.

The living is a rectory, value £800, with residence, in the gift of G. W. Heneage, Esq., the Rev. G. F. S. Powell, B.A., is the incumbent. The church (St. Leonard) is an ancient edifice, and consist of nave, aisles, and chancel; the tower contains six bells.

Here is a place of worship for Independents, and a small Free school.

Population in 1861, 885. Area in acres, 3,448; rateable value, £4,372 8s. 9d.
