



British Officer Killed By Lion

News has reached his family that Captain Leonard "William Dawson Everett, of the Welsh Regiment, has been killed in Rhodesia in an encounter with a wounded lion.

Honorable Captain Dawson, who was born in 1873 and received his commission in 1896, had been employed since 1902 with the King's African Rifles and the Somaliland Militia.

He left England this summer as the second member of the British section of the Anglo - Belgian Boundary Commission charged with the delimitation of the frontier between the Congo Free State and Northern Rhodesia.

He took part In 1902 - 1904 in the operations in Somaliland, where he was severely wounded and his services were mentioned in despatches
