

Bravery in Air Raid Posthumous Honour for Swindon Man

It has been officially announced that Aircraftman Sidney Frank (John) Garraway, of Taunton Street, Swindon, who lost his life in an air raid during November 1940 has been commended for his brave conduct.

In a letter to Mrs. Garraway from R.A.F headquarters, it is stated that Aircraftman Garraway displayed a bearing in keeping with the high traditions of the service while going to the assistance of civilians.

He leaves a widow and two children (both boys) one of whom is only twelve months old.
