Other Significant Information


Lavinia Zucker was named sole beneficiary to the will of Stanley Zucker dated 28th May 1918

William Zucker was buried on the 24th October 1918 with full military honours

Effects were sent to William's father in 2 parcels - Parcel1 from Fargo Hospital contained - Combination knife, fork and spoon; 1 silk handkerchief; Canvas pocket wallet; Card; Letters; Note Book; Leather Case; 3 Badges;, 4 Titles; 1 Ring; 1 Pencil Case; 1 Charm; Parcel 2 from Heytesbury contained - 1 Leather Jirkin; 1 Mirror; 1 Pipe; 1 Air Cushion; 2 Pocket Cases & Contents; 2 Note Books; 1 Knife & Lanyard; 1 Pair of Scissors, 1 Cigarette Holder. £1 0s. 2d. was added to Stanley's Ledger Account to be sent to is next of kin with other compensations.

In his attestation papers Stanley named Emily L. Macey of 40 Morris Road Southampton as being a friend living in the UK







