

Serious Accident

At Upton Scudamore, yesterday afternoon, a lad named Edward Townsend, in the employ of Mr. Long, farmer, of that place, was leading the horses at a thrashing machine, when he was knocked down by one of the arms of the machine, and falling on the cog-wheels, the flesh was entirely stripped from his thigh.

He was immediately conveyed, under the direction of Mr .Grubb, surgeon, to the Warminster Cottage Hospital. The injuries he received are of the most serious character.
