1809

Died at Clifton, the Rev. H. Hawes, A.M., Vicar of West Knoyle, Wilts, and of Yatton, Somersetshire Salisbury & Winchester Journal, Monday, 3 April 1809

1823

On Monday last died at Mere, in this county, in his 77th year, universally respected and regretted, Mr. William White, who had been a tenant of Sir Richard Colt Hoare, Bart, and his ancestors, upwards of fifty years. He was interred on Friday at West Knoyle; his funeral was attended by a numerous and respectable assemblage of neighbours, anxious to testify their respect for his integrity, benevolence, and general worth.
