Inquest on Charles Mills

Inquest at West Knoyle, on Charles Mills, aged 60 years.

The deceased was subject to epileptic fits and was found drowned in Knoyle Lake, lying on his face in eight inches of water; there were no external injuries of the body and it is inferred he was attacked with a fit and fell into the lake.

Verdict Found Drowned.
