Mr. Whitmarsh held an inquest, on the 21st inst., at West Knoyle, on the body of Maria Mills.

The clothes of the deceased had caught fire in the absence of the mother, which burnt her so seriously as to cause her death in a few hours afterwards.

Verdict: Accidental death.
