

## Crime and Punishment

Westport St. Mary 1850-1899

## 1870

On Sunday evening the house of Mr. Stephen Rymell, a baker and shopkeeper, in the Horse Fair, Westport, Malmesbury, was entered by a window in the back part of the house, whilst the family were at chapel, and 16s. stolen from the till. Mr. Rymell had at the time about £100 in a room upstairs, which the thief fortunately could not find. It is presumed the robbery was perpetrated by some one well acquainted with the locality.
