

Henry James Street and Family - Emigration to Canada

Henry James Street and Annie Flora Stride married in the Alderbury Registration District, in the December Quarter of 1888. Henry and Annie were listed in the 1891 Census at Whiteparish with their son Frank aged 1. Henry and Annie's ages were recorded as 24 and 23 respectively.

In the 1901 Census they were residing at The Common, Whiteparish where Henry was recorded as being a farmer, both he and his wife were native of Whiteparish. With them were their children Frank now aged 11, daughter Gladys aged 8 and Dorothy an infant under the age of 1. All of the children were born in Whiteparish.

In 1911 the family were still residing in Whiteparish. Henry was now aged 44, Annie 43, Frank 21, Gladys 15, son Stanley aged 8, Irish 5 and baby Maurice again all the children were born in Whiteparish. Sadly Dorothy Alice had died in 1904 aged 2 years and 5 months and was buried in the parish churchyard.

Emigration to Canada

Quebec City, Nov 1913, on ship "Royal George" occupation- farmer, going to sons 2 ½ and 3 years, religion – Baptist, intended destination, Arborfield, Saskatchewan. Intended occupation - farmer

Henry James Street, 44, married Minnie Florence, 45, married Morris George, 3, Gladys, 21, previous and intended occupation: domestic Stanley John, 11, Iris May, 9

Death of Henry James Street

2 Sept 1946, age 80 Spouse's name – Annie Stride, Father: John Street, Mother's name: Jerred, first name unknown. His date of birth was 8 June 1866. Death registered by his son Frank H. Street, whose address was Harbour road, Sidney. His death was sudden, due to natural causes, at his home in Menzies Street, Victoria, British Columbia. He had lived in B. C. for 4 years. He was a retired farmer, last worked in 1936, of Canadian citizenship, born in England, lived in Canada 33 years. He was married at the time of his death. He was buried 5 Sept 1946 at Royal Oak Burial Park, Saanich, Victoria, B.C.

Death Frank Henry Street

20 July 1964, at 240 Douglas Street, Victoria, B.C. aged 74. He was married to Annie Knowles, was a farmer, and last worked in 1940. Date of birth was February 9th 1890. He had been in Canada 53 years and in the Province of B.C. for 24 years, and in Victoria, B. C. for 11 years. His parents were Henry James Street and Anne Flora Stride, birthplace, Whiteparish, England. Burial was on July 23 1964, at Royal Oak Burial Park, Saanich, Victoria.

Maurice George Street, b. Whiteparish 28 Sept 1910 died Nipawin, Saskatchewan, Canada 27 Oct 1966, Farmer, truck driver, naturalist. Son of Henry James Street and Annie Flora Stride, who emigrated to a farm near Moose Range post office, Saskatchewan, in November 1913.
