the maid servant at the time of my Decease I give and handsome ring each of about three Guineas value but not a mourning ring to the two Mrs Hulberts of Speenhill near Newbury Berks Mrs Hill of Pinkwick near Corsham Wilts my Gold watch & Diamond Pin I give to Mrs Mary Cruse my brother's Widow all my wearing apparel to be equally divided between the said Mrs Mary Cruse and Winifred the Wife of James Pike of Greenhill aforesaid after paying my funeral Expences the Expences of proving my Will the Tax on the Legacies and all Debts & Claims of every kind I order all the rest and residue of my property of all descriptions to be divided in two equal parts one part I give to the said Mrs Mary Cruse and the other to the said Mr James Pike and Winifred his Wife and their respective heirs and assigns and I do hereby appoint the said Mrs Mary Cruse and the said Mr James Pike Executors of this my last Will & Testament Witness my hand this second day of May one thousand eight hundred and seven Jame Cruse Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us Bridget Watley \_ Ann Smith spinster
