Everley Petty Sessions Mr. Stephen Weeks, of Ludgershall, and Thomas Jennings of Wootton Rivers, out-door beer-house keepers, were charged with selling a half pint of beer in each case, and allowing it to be drunk on the premises on 19th of February last. The charges was proved by Mr. A. B. Richardson, officer of the Inland Revenue and defendants were fined £10.
