This is the last Will and Testament of me Thomas Somerset of East Wick in the Parish of Wootton Rivers in the County of Wilts yeoman I give and bequeath unto each of my Sisters Rebecca Banning of Ogbourne Saint George in the said County of Wilts and Mary Brown of Broad Hinton in the said County of Wilts the sum of two hundred pounds each I give to my sister Elizabeth the wife of Edmund Somerset of Milton in the said County of Wilts Yeoman the sum of two hundred pounds to be enjoyed and disposed of by her as her separate estate without the control or interference of her present or any future husband and her receipt to be notwithstanding coverture an effectual discharge for the same I give to the five children of my late Sister Ann Briant the sum of two hundred pounds to be equally divided amongst them share and share alike and I direct my Executors to pay the legacy duty and expences chargeable the aforesaid pecuniary legacies so that

the legatees may receive the full amount thereof I devise and bequeath all and receive all the residue and remainder of my real and personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever and appoint all the real and personal estate over which I have any power of appointeeship unto my brothers William Somerset of Barton in the Parish of Preshute in the said County of Wilts Yeoman and John Somerset of Lambourn in the County of Berks Surgeon their heirs and assigns for ever to be equally divided amongst them share and share alike as tenants in common but as to estates vested in me upon trust by way of a mortgage subject to equities affecting the same and I appoint the said William Somerset and John Somerset to be Executors of this my will and hereby revoke all other wills In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this twenty fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four *Thos Somerset*
