

Letter from the Vicarage



Summer; and several things are floating round my mind. To take just three: an unprecedented number of baptisms, the end of the school year and holiday club. The common theme seems to be children. Children loved to be with Jesus, maybe because he valued them in a way that most adults in his time did not. He once used a child as an example and said to the gathered crowd: 'unless you become like a little child you cannot enter the Kingdom of God'. So what did Jesus mean? Here's an example of what I think he was saying.

Some months ago I took a school assembly on the theme of creation. We looked at some ash tree seeds, a sapling and a photo of the full grown tree from which the seeds had come. The children were particularly taken with the 'wing' on the seeds which enable them to glide to a new spot.

Some days later I went to Potterne village shop. On the seat outside were a couple of the school children. They wanted to ask me about the tree under which they were sitting. "Is it an ash?" they said, "The seeds have got wings." I explained it was a sycamore, as ash seeds are not the only ones with wings. One of the children then said: "God must be really awesome to have such brilliant ideas." Fantastic!

What a shame it is that as we get older we lose the ability a child has to wonder, and see how things around us can point to the creator of the universe. We get cynical and sceptical and want to analyse everything.

Now, I certainly think we should try and understand the world around us. I trained years ago to be a scientist. Science is about explaining the world, and it has brought untold benefits to humanity. I believe God has given us minds and inquisitive natures so we can discover new things for the good of all. But if on the way we lose a sense of wonder, and of being creatures given a special role in creation by God himself, we have lost something important.

Psalm 8, one of the great songs of the Old Testament, encourages us to look at creation and think about God the creator, and our role in what He has made. As the writer looks to the stars and the sky, humanity seems so small. And yet he remembers that we are made 'just a little lower than the angels', in fact the pinnacle of all creation.

This summer give yourself a break and take some time to really look at things around you. The scales on a butterfly's wing, the petals of a wild flower, the swifts screaming overhead in the village. Look at them through the eyes of a child and give thanks to God for the wonder of His creation.



Recreation grounds – draining works

Please be aware that the play area at Sandleaze has now been land drained and the soil will be allowed to settle down naturally before it is levelled. This means that the area is unsightly but it should mean that the play equipment can be used for more of the year.

C20 – Speedwatch and working with other councils

The Council is concerned about speeds and safety on the C20 road from Worton to Seend and continues to work with surrounding parishes to improve road safety including controlling speeds and reducing inappropriate overtaking. Cllr Whitehead, portfolio holder for Highways at Wiltshire Council, attended our recent meeting and explained the difficulty with implementing changes on this road.

Please do not park your cars on the pavements - it forces pedestrians to step into our busy High Street and it is illegal. Please also cut back any vegetation which comes from your property and obstructs a road or pavement. Please place your wheely bin at the edge of your property for collection such that it provides the minimum possible obstruction to the pavement.

10K SPONSORED WALK FOR SALISBURY HOSPITAL CHILDREN'S WARD

As it was recently "Diabetic awareness week", we felt that this was a good time to share our story about an amazing and brave 12 year old, who over the past four months has been on quite a journey!

On 22nd February 2016, our daughter was rushed in to Salisbury hospital A&E where the resuscitation team were waiting to revive a child whose veins had collapsed. This was causing every feasible alarm on the monitor to which she was hooked up to bleep and flag up danger after danger as her body started to shut down.

She was diagnosed with "Ketoacidosis" which is a dangerous and life threatening stage of Type 1 diabetes. Fifteen hours later we were thankfully told that she was finally out of danger.

With a crash course on what this all means for now and in the future, the three of us were taught how to inject the insulin, and she was finally discharged on 25th February 2016.

She was so weak when we left the hospital that we had to take her out in a wheelchair to the car. As we reached the main entrance, she noticed a sign advertising "Walk for Wards", a sponsored walk being held on 3rd July 2016. "I'm going to do that" she said, *and guess what? SHE DID!!!*

This is why we wanted to share this story, because we are so incredibly proud of the fact that not only did Becky not feel sorry for herself, but decided to channel her frustration and energy into raising money for others, as her way of saying thank you to the wonderful hospital staff that helped to save her life and who looked after her so well


We wanted to say a heartfelt thank you to all our friends in the village for their support and contributions towards Becky's 10k Sponsored walk. As well as donations received on her "Just Giving" page, to date, Becky has raised £900.00 which she has chosen to donate to the Sarum Children's ward/Children's diabetic clinic.
