I give to my wife JANE POPE for her own use absolutely also all my goods and chattels whatsoever and wheresoever that I shall di? possest of I give and bequeath unto my said wife JANE POPE as her own and I do hereby appoint my said wife JANE POPE as my sole executive to this my last Will and Testament and do the same with the payment of all my past debts and funeral expenses do witness my hand and seal this Seventh day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Six - WILLIAM POPE - signed sealed published and declared to be
