## Hankerton

**Hankerton** is a parish and village, distant 4 miles W from Minety station, and 4 N E from Malmesbury, in Malmesbury union and hundred, and Cricklade parliamentary borough, North Wilts.

The living is a vicarage, in the patronage of the rector of Crudwell, and held by the Rev Wm Buckland, M.A. The church (Holy Cross) is an ancient and large structure, in the Early English style, consisting of a fine lofty tower, with four bells.

Here is a National School

The population in 1861 was 277, whereof 23 is in Cloatley; the area in acres, 2,150; rateable value, £2,895.

The Earl of Suffolk is lord of the manor.

**Cloatley** is a tithing, half a mile E.
