I give and bequeath my Soul up into the hands of Almighty God my maker hopeing that through the death and passion of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ to have a free pardon of all my Sinns And as for my Body to be buryed in Christian buryall according to the discretion of my Executor hereafter named

Item I give and bequeath unto **John Peggler** one of the sonns of my Brother **Stephen Peggler** twenty shillings to be payd by my Executor in the first and next year after my death

Item I give unto his sonne **Luke** the like sume and to be payd as the former

I give unto Joane Cliffe widdow the sume of twenty shillings to be payd according to the time of the former Item I give unto Mary Cliffe the Daughter of the said Joane twenty shillings alsoe and to be payd as the former Item I give unto Joane Peggler twenty shillings to be payd as the former Item I give unto Jonathan Cliffe and to his Brother Daniel one shilling apeece Item Item I give unto my Brother Richard Davis one shilling Item I give unto my Sister Joane Peggler one shilling and now in the next place I make and ordaine Stephen Peggler the younger to be my Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament revokeing and renounceing all others formerly by me made or ever for me caused to be made and to this I set my hand and seale the day and year above written ----- John Davis -----Published and Declared in the presence of us ------ Henry Smith ----- Mary Peggler jun her marke ----- 15011 231140 cuti vivo Coorgio Damuston Logum Dortore
