The Station early 1900's

1882	1 May	Opening of Swindon, Marlborough & Andover Railway Station (Midland and South-Western Junction Railway)
1900	28 Aug	Double line to Weyhill began operating
1901	1 Sept	Double line to Collingbourne began operating
1902	1 July	Tidworth branch opened for goods
1902	1 Oct	Tidworth branch opened for passengers
1903		Engine shed opened
1925		Engine shed closed
1950	2 Apr	British Railways (Southern Region) take over
1958	1 Feb	British Railways (Western Region) take over
1961	11 Sep	Station closed to passengers/Swindon line closed
1963	31 Jul	Tidworth branch closed
1964	24 Mar	Closed for public goods
