In the Name of God Amen The two and twentyth day of May in the yeare of our Lord God one thousand six hundred fifty eight I John Lovelocke the elder of Warminster in the County of Wilts blacksmith, being sicke and weake in body, but of sound and pfect memory (thanks I render to God for the same) Doe make this my last Will and Testament in manner and forme following ffirst I give all my Shop of tooles unto my Sone Nathaniel Lovelocke , and three Pounds of lawfull English money, and all my Estate, terme of yeares, claime, and demand of, in, and to, Six acres of arable land more or lesse which I lately bought of George Smart, and one coffer. Alsoe, I give unto my Sonne Charles Lovelocke Six pounds of lyke lawfull money. Alsoe I give unto my three daughters the Sum of foure pounds a piece of lyke lawfull money. Item I give unto my daughter Mirrable my last wives gold ring, my least brasse pott, and two of my best barrells, and one canvas Sheete. And all the rest of my linnen equally betwixt my sd three daughters. Alsoe, I give unto my daughter Anne my Chest, and the gold ring that was her owne mother's ring. Alsoe, I give unto my daughter Mary one blankett and one flockbed. I give unto my sd daughter Anne the coverlett which belongs to my bed wherein I lodge, and one flockbed. Alsoe I give unto my Sonne Nathaniel my truckle bedstead, and all the bedding belonging to the same. All the rest of mine

estate I give wholly, and intirely, to my Sonne John Lovelocke whom I constitute the whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament which I certify, and confirme, revoking hereby all former and other Wills by mee made whatsoever. In witness whereof I have hereunto Sett mone hand and Seale the day, and yeare first above written. The marke of John Lovelocke Senr.
