Item I give unto my daughter Mirrable my last wives gold ring, my least brasse pott, and two of my best barrells, and one canvas Sheete. And all the rest of my linnen equally betwixt my sd three daughters. Alsoe, I give unto my daughter Anne my Chest, and the gold ring that was her owne mother's ring. Alsoe, I give unto my daughter Mary one blankett and one flockbed. I give unto my sd daughter Anne the coverlett which belongs to my bed wherein I lodge, and one flockbed.
