Death of Canon Arthur George Peters

Canon Arthur Edward George Peters, of Newbridge Hill, Bath, who was buried on Monday following a service at St John's, Lower Weston, collapsed while walking in the Lower Bristol road at Bath three weeks ago. He was conveyed to hospital and died on Wednesday last week.

From 1917 till his comparatively recent retirement, he was vicar of Bremhill, with Foxham and Highway St Peter, Wilts. Previously he was at Marlborough for 12 years and he had been Rural Dean first of Marlborough and later of Avebury.

Ordained in 1891, he held curacies at Gillingham, Dorset, and St Albans and Fulham before undertaking various positions in the diocese of Salisbury, including that of Chaplain to the Bishop.
