Other Significant Information	
It would appear that John was born illegitimate	
His mother Ellen Sweatman Viney later married Charles Bracher who had been a boarder at the Compass Inn in 1901. The marriage took place at St. John's Church, Tisbury on the 27th April 1901	
His mother was widowed in August 1908 and Charles Bracher was buried on the 21st August 1908 in Sutton Mandeville	
His mother remarried at St. John's Tisbury on 13th November 1909 to Alfred Thick	
At present we have not found any other memorial or commemorative plaque naming Private Viney.
