In the name of God Amen I Robert Ladd of Calne in the Countie of Wiltes Carpenter being sicke in bodie but of good and perfect memorie I thanke God therefore doe make this my last will and Testament in manner and forme following that is to saye ffirst I bequeath my Soule into the hands of Almightye God whoe hath made me and all the world And in Jesus Christ his only sonne our Lord whoe hath redeemed me And..... Item I give unto my daughter ffrancis Ladd the best Chest and the best C.... and the best Tablebord and the side board in my Lodgeing Chamber Item I give unto my daughter Alice Ladd ten shillinges in money Item I give unto my daughter Joane ffranklin five shillinges in money Item I give unto my daughter Judith three pound Item I give unto my daughter Maria the best bedd with the appurtenances thereunto

belonging and the best brasse pott and the Chest in the other Chamber her Mother to have the use of it for soe long as she liveth Item I give unto my Man James all my wearing apparrell and all my workeing tools Item I give unto my Servant Maide fyve shillings in money Item I give unto my Brother my best The rest of my goods moveable and imoveable I give and bequeath unto my wife Alice Ladd whome I make my whole and sole Executor And I nominate and appoint to be my Overseers in trust Jeremie Baylie and Henry Ladd In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seale
