Two Penruddocke Monuments in Churchyard About 1.5 Metres North of Chancel of Church of ST. Michael

Compton Chamberlayne

Grade II - Listed 17th December, 1986

Two coffin lids within formerly railed enclosure. Late C18.

Chamfered limestone rectangular coffin lids on low plinths within kerb with pitched coping. Both lids with heraldic arms carved in low relief, south of pair has inscription to Henrietta Penruddocke died 1761, north inscription illegible.
