Leaving to those Who placed all their hopes Of earthly Happinenefs on most Dutiful and Affectionate Son No other Support Under their heavy lofs Than that which they derive from Resignation to the Will of God. Yet shall he live" John XI 25 ver.</p>

O'Bryen	Gertrude Grace	<p style="text-align: center;">Here rest the mortal remains of GERTRUDE GRACE O'BRYEN the beloved Wife of Lord Edward O'Bryen third daughter of Paul Cobb Methuen Esq^r. She fell asleep on May 1st 1817 Aged 29 Years</p> <p>Him that cometh unto me, I will in no wise cast out Sweet corn of wheat committed to the ground To die and live and hear more precious ear While in the heart of earth thy Saviour found His place of rest, for thee we will not fear Sleep softly till that blessed rain and dew Down lighting upon earth, such change shall bring That all its fields of death shall laugh anew Yea, with a living harvest, laugh and sing</p>
Skeate	Edwin	<p style="text-align: center;">In Loving Memory of EDWIN SKEATE, M.R.C.S. L.S.A. of Bath Born in this parish Dec^r. 12 1811, Died at Bath May 7 1907, buried in the adjoining churchyard This tablet was erected by his grand nieces in grateful remembrance</p>
Wallis	Ezekiel	<p style="text-align: center;">In Memory of EZEKIEL WALLIS Esq^r. of Lucknam near this place; only Son and sole Heir of James Wallis Esq^r. From whom he inherited an Ample Fortune, which he employed on Acts of Generosity and Benevolence He died December the 31st 1734 Aged 43 Years Also of Cecilia his Wife, The youngest Daughter of Isaac Selfe Esq^r. of Beanacre in this County by Penelope his Wife, Daughter and Coheirs of Charles Lord Lucas Baron of Shenfield in Essex who married secondly The Worshipful John Coxed, L.L.D. Warden of Winchester College whom she likewise survived and departed this Life January the 31st 1760, Aged 60 Years Paul Methuen Esq^r. Her Nephew and Heir caused This Marble to be erected</p>

<p>Paul Methuen (Side Panel)</p>	<p>PAUL METHUEN Efq^r. who lyes here interred died January 22nd 1795 Aged 72 Years He was the only Son of Thomas Methuen Efq^r. of this County: Alfo Heir of his Mother's Family the Selves of Beanacre: And of the Right Hon^{ble}. S^r. Paul Methuen Knight of the Bath He had lfsue by Christian his Wife Two Sons Paul Cobb Methuen Efq^r. his eldesft Son and Heir@ Thomas who died before him And one Daughter Christian Married to Frederick Lord Boston.</p> <p>He that walketh uprightly walketh furely.</p>
<p>Thomas Methuen (side panel)</p>	<p>THOMAS METHUEN Second Son of Paul Methuen Efq^r. and Christian his Wife Died at Nice in the Dominions of Savoy where he went for the recovery of his Haelth April the 27th 1774. Aged 20 Years and was interred in the Vault Under this Tomb, the 21 of July following</p> <p>Oh just beheld and lost admir'd and mourn'd With ev'ry Virtue ev'ry Grace adorn'd.</p>
