Stanton St. Quintin

THIS parish, which includes Lower Stanton, is situated 2 miles from Hullavington and 5 miles each from Chippenham and Malmesbury G.W.R. Stations, and is in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District of Chippenham, and Diocese of Bristol. The Church of St. Giles, containing beautiful examples of Roman architecture, has a register dating back to the year 1560, and the living is a rectory of the net yearly value of £221, with residence. There is a Primitive Methodist Chapel at Lower Stanton. Stanton St. Quintin Park is a wood extending over 200 acres. Area, 1,807 acres; rateable value, £1,823; population 236. Letters arrive through Chippenham at 8.15 a.m. and 4.30 p.m.; the wall box is cleared at 11.5 a.m. and 7 p.m., and that of Lower Stanton at 10.50 a.m. and 6.50 p.m. There is a Post Office at Upper Stanton, and the nearest Telegraph Office is at Hullavington.
