Thomas Carter, charged with having stolen a piece of beef, the property
of Robert Blackford, at Swindon. Guilty: 3 months imprisonment.

William Wiltshire, thrice tried, to be imprisoned one month for stealing a quantity of brass, the property of
Robert Buddulph and Lionel Walter, esqrs., at Slaughterford, one month for stealing brass, the property of
Thomas Wiltshire, at Slaughterford, and to be transported for seven years, for stealing gun-metal, the
property of the Great Western Railway Company, at Swindon.
